We did receive our match for 2002, but will have to wait and see if the matching grants can be restored for 2003. To help augment QI's funding for these important programs, clubs have been asked to take part in the Wanda Frey Joiner Development Fund "2003 Pot of Gold Sweepstakes" tickets. The tickets are \$100 each, and can be split between several persons. We have a club ticket going now, with \$25 left to purchase, but individual club members may take tickets to sell outside the club.
