### Directions to Connie's House

15 Morningside Drive, Indiana, PA 724-463-3295

**From Indiana:** Take 119 S towards the Holiday Inn, turn left from the left turn lane onto Stutzman road which is located between Dale Oxygen (formerly Coyne's) and McGill's Car World. Morningside Drive is the second left, and the house is the 3<sup>rd</sup> one on the left.

**From Indian Springs Road coming from the light at 6<sup>th</sup> Street Extension:** Turn right onto Home Farm road at the top of the hill, turn left at the stop sign at Coates, continue to the next stop sign and turn right onto Winchester, then next left onto Stutzman and finally right onto Morningside. The house is the 3<sup>rd</sup> on the left.

There is parking for 6 cars in the driveway, street parking or you may want to car pool from the Holiday Inn.

### Directions to Whitey's Peetza

Located just off Route 119 Hwy. between Blairsville and Homer City.

If traveling North on Hwy. 119 from Blairsville: go to 2nd red light, turn left, and make a quick right. Travel 5 blocks. Whitey's will be on your left.

If traveling South on Hwy. 119: at the red light (Homer City) of intersection Route 954 and Hwy. 119 go South on Hwy. 119 towards Blairsville. At the next red light turn right, and make a quick right. Travel 5 blocks. Whitey's will be on your left.
