Quota International of Indiana held a special mentoring event for young men and women in the community on June 21 at the S&T Bank Training Center.

The program was designed to offer information on interviewing and answer questions by the youth about possible careers.

Professionals from throughout the Indiana community representing a number of careers presented during the day-long event. Presenters included:

Quota International Inc. is an 88-year-old international service organization that links members of all ages, occupations and nationalities in a worldwide network of service and friendship. With a motto of "we share," Quotarians are known especially for their service to deaf, hard-of-hearing and speech impaired individuals and disadvantaged women and children.

Quota International of Indiana, with 50 active members, meets monthly at the Indiana Elks for a dinner meeting August through May. Quota of Indiana celebrated its 51th anniversary in September 2006.

Over the past four years, Quota and The Coney have together raised almost \$18,000 to support initiatives for women and children at the Alice Paul House, including a new playground at the facility. Quotarians also collect specific items of need throughout the club year for the Alice Paul House.

Quotarians raised almost \$7,000 during the second annual St. Patty's Day Open in March 16, an indoor nine-hole golfing event in Downtown Indiana to raise funds for the club's service projects.

Quotarians will continue mentoring events with a July all-day recreational event with the student group.

Quota International representatives also took part in the community's June 1 "Stand for Children" event in Indiana County.

Quota of Indiana also recently purchased a classroom amplification system for children who are hard of hearing for the Purchase Line School District.
